



## 2021-22 Distribution Update

This year, we sent our **second shipment of Portuguese Helios units to Brazil** (800 Solar, 200 USB) as well as a shipment of **English Helios units to Kenya** (400 USB).

We have prepared a shipment of **Spanish Helios units** (800 Solar, 800 USB) for **Ecuador** and will be shipping them as soon as the customs officials and shipping providers give us the green light.



In the beginning of the next fiscal year, we anticipate another shipment to Kenya of over 1,000 Helios units and another shipment to Brazil of over 700 Helios units.

## 2021-22 Donor Report

We shared the Helios projects with thousands of people through **focused challenges on 6 different radio stations and networks** this past year. Those challenges involved 369 donors (last year it was 213 donors from 4 stations), and they provided **2,663 Helios units** (last year it was 897 units) for untrained pastors and Christian workers in Brazil (Portuguese), Ecuador (Spanish), and Kenya (English).



We continue to share the Helios Projects thousands of times each week, to over a million listeners through our sponsorship of the radio feature “Truth Itself” on over 400 stations nationwide. In 2021-22, we had **507 new donors and 244 of those new donors** were from this sponsorship!



## 2021-22 Translation Report

The Translation Progress for the Helios Projects in 2021-22 could be characterized by the title of Clint Eastwood’s 1966 film “The Good, the Bad and the Ugly.”

**The Good:** **(1)** The **Russian CT Project** translation and recording are **complete!** We are working on the final matters that will prepare the Project for production and then distribution. **(2)** We started a **Nepali** translation/recording team in 2021-22. They are taking on both the CT and GS Projects. **(3)** The **Creole CT Project** has completed translation of the notes and recording of the audio files. They are going back to make some updates to the audio files and the Project should them be completed. **(4)** We are close to completing the work to finish an Agreement and form an **Arabic** translation/recording team.

**The Bad:** **(5)** We have not yet finished the steps necessary to finish an Agreement and form a **French** translation/recording team. This will be a priority in 2022-23. **(6)** The contact who was going to help us get a full translation/recording of the **Helios CT Project in Mandarin** contracted long-term Covid and has been quarantined, or isolated for 6 months and we have made no progress in addressing this need.

**(7)** The **Helios CT Project in Afrikaans** hit a snag just as the Project leader believed they were nearing completion of the Project. The main proofreader refused to work on several sections of the Project and threatened the “voice” of the Project with ex-communication from his church if he worked on those sections with which he (the proofreader) disagreed. **Pray** as we are definitely facing spiritual battles to get these Projects completed, produced, and distributed to those who need them!

**The Ugly: (8)** After telling us for over three and a half years that the **Swahili CT Project** was completed, and making multiple attempts to get the Project (including taking two trips to Kenya to physically get the Project), we have made the difficult decision to walk away from the Project Coordinator and start the Project all over again. We have never received the translated notes from him and have only received 20% of the audio files. I (Timothy Kroll, President) apologize for the hurt this Project Coordinator’s actions have caused our ministry and you our donating champions. While the funds expended will need to be expended again with the restart of the work, and that is painful, the greater loss is the five-plus years lost that would have seen the Project now in distribution to untrained pastors and Christian workers all over east Africa. **Pray** as we work to find a new Project Coordinator and put together a new translation/recording team.
